Sustainable Arnside - Financial Procedures Policy

This policy was adopted on 17 October 2024

General

- 1. Sustainable Arnside (SA) has a management committee which is elected at the AGM.
- 2. The Committee consists of the Chair, the Secretary, the Treasurer, and two other elected Members.
- 3. The Committee is responsible for ensuring that the group is well managed, that income is supervised and put to best use, and implementing this policy.

Financial Records

- 1. SA will keep appropriate financial records including:
 - An account book or spreadsheet recording all the transactions in the bank account
 - Bank statements
 - Petty cash records
 - · Details of all funds received
 - Invoices and other receipts for all payment
- 2. SA financial year ends on 31st July.
- 3. SA will draw up accounts at the end of the financial year and within 2 months of the year end to be presented at the AGM.
- 4. The year end accounts will be independently examined by a qualified independent examiner.
- 5. A financial report will be given by the treasurer at meetings of SA showing money received, payments and remaining funds. The report will also show expected future receipts.
- 6. Accounts for individual projects will be recorded separately. The year end accounts will make clear the distinction between receipts and expenses for these individual projects.

Bank/Income/Expenditure

- 1. SA has a current account with Santander in the name of SUSTAINABLE ARNSIDE.
- 2. The bank statement will be reconciled with the cash book every month by the Treasurer.
- 3. Payments from SA bank accounts will be supported by an original invoice.
- 4. Payments above £200 must be agreed by 3 Committee members of SA.
- 3. Cash payments for subscriptions and donations will be issued with a receipt.
- 4. Expenditure in cash, through the petty cash system, shall be kept to a minimum and for small amounts (maximum £20).
- 5. Payments by cheque, direct debit bank transfer or debit card:
 - Cheques, direct debits, BACS or debit card payments will NOT be made without paperwork to support the payment
 - Cheque payment two signatories are required
 - No cheques must be signed by the person to whom it is payable
 - Blank cheques will NEVER be signed
